

2. Mature Age Entry Scheme

Candidates seeking admission through this mode must satisfy the following conditions:

- Be at least 25 years old on the first day of the academic year in which admission is sought;
- They should preferably have successfully completed junior secondary education; and
- Normally have proof of at least five years relevant work experience relating to the proposed study programme.
- Mature Age applications close on 17 June.

ADMISSION Requirements

 Subject to Faculty specific regulations, the normal basic requirements for admission to CODeL undergraduate programmes shall be a Namibia Senior Secondary Certificate (NSSC).

Certificate Programmes

 Passed five subjects with a minimum of 17 points on the UNAM Evaluation Scale including a grade E or better in English (as a Second Language) at NSSC.

Diploma Programmes

- To register for a diploma programme, a candidate must hold an NSSC or equivalent qualification, obtained in not more than three (3) examination sittings, with a minimum score of 22 in five (5) subjects on the UNAM Evaluation Scale.
- English is a compulsory subject and should have been obtained at English as First/Second Language NSSC Ordinary level, symbol D or higher.
- A candidate can be admitted to the programme through the University's Mature Age Entry Scheme.

Diploma in Educational Management and Leadership

To qualify for admission to the Diploma, a candidate must meet the following requirements:

- Basic Education Teachers Diploma (BETD) (Level 6) or equivalent; and
- At least three years of teaching experience

Diploma in Secondary Education (Professional Training)

To qualify for admission to the Diploma, a candidate must meet the following requirements:

- A recognised Bachelor's degree at least at NQF level 7 or equivalent, with two school subjects and completed a minimum of 7 semester modules in school subject 1 and 8 semester modules in school subject 2, respectively; or
- Candidates who are qualified artisans as recognised by NTA and with two years teaching experience can also offer technological subjects as school subjects; and
- Applicants may also be required to attend interviews and other relevant aptitude tests.
- Further subject/departmental regulations will apply, e.g. school subject combinations.

Diploma in Secondary Education (Specialisation in Biology/English/Mathematics/ Physical Science)

To qualify for admission to the Diploma, a candidate must meet the following requirements:

- Basic Education Teachers Diploma (BETD) (Level
 6) or equivalent, with a major in the school subject specialisation area, grades 8 to 10, and
- At least two years of teaching experience in the school subject specialisation on Junior Secondary level. Proof of experience must be provided by the Principal, and
- A pass in an entry test for the school subject specialization with 70%. The Faculty reserves the right to ask prospective students to do additional academic work before they are allowed in the programme.

Degree Programmes

- To register for an undergraduate degree programme, a candidate must hold a valid Namibian Senior Secondary Certificate (NSSC) or a recognised equivalent qualification.
- English is a compulsory subject and should normally have been obtained as a Second Language at NSSCO level with a minimum C-symbol (B-symbol for Bachelor of Arts in English), or English as a First Language at NSSCO level with a minimum D-symbol. (C-symbol for Bachelor of Arts in English.
- A candidate should obtain a minimum of 25 points on the UNAM Evaluation Point Scale in his/her five (5) best subjects (of which English must be one) to be admitted to undergraduate studies.
