Application for 2021 study permit is now open.

The International Students' Office would like to bring the following study permit information to all international students' attention.

Especially, first year students **that have to** be physically present in Namibia for classes (as from 01 March); international students not yet in the country, but would be **traveling at a later stage**, Covid-19 restraints permitting, for physical class attendance (sometime after 01 March), and any international student **currently in Namibian borders**.

Students that have to travel before 01 March

1. First year international students that have to travel before class commence on 01 March, should use their **Provisional Admission Letters** at the border checkpoints when entering the country.
2. All international students studying at **Main Campus**, and when or currently in Namibia, are required to submit their application forms at the Ministry of Home Affairs, Immigration, Safety & Security (MHAISS) in Windhoek, latest by 26 February.

Prior submission, you are advised to make a copy/take a picture of your payment receipt and keep it safe for future reference. Upon submission, make sure you receive an **Acknowledgement Receipt** (that states that your application form has been submitted). Keep it safe for follow up or future enquiries.

3. All international students at University satellite campuses (i.e. not based at the Main Campus in Windhoek) must submit their study permit application forms at the respective Student Support Office, latest by 26 February. Generally, the SRC members at each campus render efficient assistance to international students during the study permit application period – do seek their support if/when on campus.

Currently in Namibian borders

1. All international students currently in the country (Namibia) are advised to apply for study permits now (until 26 February). Temporary permits are currently valid until 28 February 2021.
2. Make sure you have all needed documents as stipulated on the list of requirements. Kindly visit the website to familiarize yourself with the requirements.

Traveling at a later stage

International students currently in their home countries, and studying through online platform – most likely to travel sometime after 01 March – will be informed on how to apply for their study permits if/when face-to-face teaching commences.

Study permit application closing date

26 February 2021 (no late submission will be accepted).
