

Pay online to access all services

Last day to pay all outstanding fees was 30 November.

In accordance with University regulations, UNAM shall withhold examination results of a student with outstanding fees.

2nd semester provisional exam results shall be available on the student portal as from 09 December (and final exam results on 15 Dec).

UNAM closes on 16 December at 16h30 for the academic year 2022, and re-opens on 12 January 2023, at 07h30.

Pay Online to access your results

Should a student be making payment after the University has closed, and would like to be granted instant access to their semester results through the student portal, must then make such payment via the UNAM online payment platform.

Online payment should be made via the UNAM website at: www.unam.edu.na/online-payment

Payment made at a bank or by EFT, after the University has closed, will only be allocated to the designate student account when the University re-opens in 2023.

Access to the student portal is only possible when all outstanding fees have been settled.
