Dear Students,

This serves to urgently inform that the University Executive Management has decided as follows regarding the 2022 First Semester teaching and learning. This comes after reviewing its previous decision on the matter as communicated, and against the background of the new COVID-19 Regulations:

1. All teaching at the University of Namibia for all fulltime students will take place in the form of face-to-face classes, supported by online learning and teaching. This includes first-year and senior students registered on fulltime mode. It excludes students enrolled in different modes such as distance students, and those studying online programmes.
2. Following that online classes started on 14 February 2022, face-to-face classes for senior students will resume on **28 February 2022**. This is also applicable to international students.
3. The resolutions above are not applicable to students who are enrolled for programmes that are FULLY ONLINE.
4. All UNAM libraries will be open for extended periods as posted on social media, the library website, and at the entrance of each library.
5. Virtual library services and online resources will continue to be accessible to the users at all times.
6. COVID-19 protocols will be strictly enforced at all campuses.
7. The University Executive Management encourages all staff members and students to get vaccinated.
