# Learn Another Language





The Department of Language Development in the School of Humanities, Society & Development is offering the following semester and year courses (on part-time and full-time basis; subject to minimum participation):

# 1. English Access Course

The English Access Course focuses on English language skills; mainly reading, speaking, writing and listening. The course is designed for students who have completed Grade 12 with a minimum of 25 points (that is; top 4 subjects should be 22 points plus English with E or D-symbol).

These students have reached the minimum required points for admission to UNAM, except the required minimum C grade in English. The English Access Course is a one (1) year full-time course, aimed at bringing the students' English to par with the minimum requirements for UNAM.

# 2. English for Multipurpose

For employees in private corporate and public sectors who wish to improve their English language skills for business communication purposes: mature candidates who wish to write the English Mature Age Entry Examination, and those individuals who wish to improve their general language skills.

(basic, for non-speakers of the local languages)
