

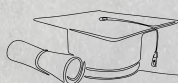

**SILAGE PRODUCTION FROM ENCROACHER BUSH  
(*SENEGALIA MELLIFERA*) AND ITS EFFECTS ON MILK YIELD  
AND COMPOSITION OF LACTATING COWS**



*The doctoral study was undertaken and completed under the supervision of Dr. Maria N. T. Shipandeni (Main Supervisor) and Prof. Johnfisher Mupangwa and Prof. Emmanuel Lutaaya (Co-Supervisors), both from the University of Namibia*

The study evaluated the fermentation and nutritional quality of *Senegalia mellifera* (black thorn) biomass silage prepared with different carbohydrate additives, biological inoculants, and ensiling durations, as well as the effects of *S. mellifera* silage-based supplementation on milk yield and composition of lactating cows. A combination of research methods, including laboratory analyses, *in vitro* digestibility studies, and feeding experiments were conducted.

Carbohydrate additives improved fermentation quality and nutrient composition, producing silage with lower pH, reduced fiber, and higher dry matter and crude protein content. Supplementation of grazing communal cows during the dry season showed that the *S. mellifera* silage was readily consumed and tended to increase milk yield and lactose content, while body weight and most milk composition parameters remained similar to cows grazing without supplementation. In Holstein cows, *S. mellifera* silage-based supplementation maintained milk yield comparable to a commercial dairy supplement and supported higher body weights despite lower feed intake. The study concluded that browsable biomass from the encroacher bush *S. mellifera* can be effectively preserved through ensiling with additives and utilised as a supplementary feed for lactating cattle during the dry season, contributing to sustainable livestock production and improved rangeland management in Namibia.

**A GROUNDED THEORY STUDY: DESIGNING FOR  
INFORMATION PRIVACY IN DIGITAL IDENTITY INTEGRATION  
IN NAMIBIA**



*The doctoral study was undertaken and completed under the supervision of Prof. Nicola J. Bidwell (Main Supervisor) from the University of Rhodes, South Africa and Charles Darwin University, Australia and Dr Paulus Sheetekela (Co-Supervisor) from the International University of Management, Namibia.*

The study sought to construct a viable information privacy-enhanced software architecture and supporting models for a National Identity Exchange System (NIDES) for Namibia, informed by an investigation of legal identity user experiences, practices, and needs in relation to information privacy and the verification, sharing and exchange of legal identity information within different contextual situations.

The study advances a theory of legal identity disclosure that explains how users decide when to disclose legal identity information, highlighting the contextual conditions, privacy concerns, and constraints influencing these decisions. It identifies implications for system design, data management, and policy, emphasising that information privacy is dynamic and context-dependent. The findings suggest that digital identity systems should move beyond one-size-fits-all approaches and prioritise user-centred privacy, transparency, accountability, and contextual trust-building.

The study further contributes to integration and Privacy-by-Design for national identity system research by advancing a Namibia-specific design for a NIDES, which fosters trust through a consent framework aligned with local practices while balancing system integration with information privacy to improve data exchange, safeguards, and digital inclusion. This is a shift from the commonly used centralised hub model to a distributed architecture that integrates foundational and functional identity systems in multiple directions.

*The doctoral study was undertaken and completed under the supervision of Dr Frans Persendt (Main Supervisor) from the University of Namibia, and Christopher Gomez (Co-Supervisor) from Kobe University, Japan*

The study investigated marine fisheries monitoring practices in Namibia's Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) and explored integrated approaches to strengthen governance, surveillance, and sustainable management of marine resources.

The study developed an integrated framework that brings together governance coordination, geospatial analysis, and policy alignment to strengthen fisheries monitoring in Namibia's EEZ. The findings provide evidence-based best practices for improving surveillance, enhancing institutional collaboration, and supporting research-based decision-making to combat illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated (IUU) fishing and promote sustainable management of marine resources. The framework also offers insights that can inform fisheries governance and monitoring approaches in other coastal states, globally, facing similar challenges.

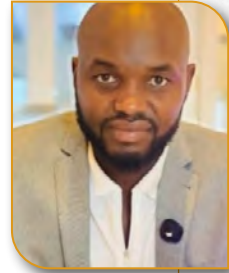

**QUANTIFICATION OF MODEL UNCERTAINTIES IN FINANCIAL  
DERIVATIVES MARKETS**

*The doctoral study was undertaken and completed under the supervision Dr Rodrigue Gnitchogna Batogna from the Namibia University of Science and Technology.*

The study investigated the assessment and measurement of financial risks arising from the use of financial derivatives with the focus on markets where a unique measure of risk does not exist, incomplete markets.

The candidate developed a framework for the quantification of risks emanating from financial derivatives incorporating jump processes in the description of the price dynamics of the underlying assets. He expanded the body of work on stochastic analysis of jump-processes and expanded the body of work on locally risk-minimizing strategies by partial quadratic hedging of both the diffusion and jump process, into a holistic framework that captured the residual risk in deep learning neural networks.

#### THE ROOT CAUSES OF THE PROLIFERATION OF NEW CHURCHES IN NAMIBIA.

*The doctoral study was undertaken and completed under the supervision of Dr Hendrik R. Tjibeba (Main Supervisor), as well as Dr Archford Muzodza, and Prof Emeritus Paul John Isaak (Co- Supervisors) all from the University of Namibia*



The purpose of this study was to determine the salient contribution factors which result in some Namibians leaving the earlier denominations for new churches. It creates an awareness and understanding amongst Namibians that the landscape of evangelisation is swiftly changing. While expeditious of emergence of new churches comes along with a myriad of societal and religious challenges, it also devices positive pastoral possibilities.

The study proposed a comprehensive model that when the gospel is profoundly entrenched in the hearts of the evangelised, it recognises and contributes towards the elevation of their cultural identity and dignity. Genuine modern evangelism should embody holistic therapeutic psychological, bodily and emotional values which eventually becomes a catalyst for socio-economic emancipation from the clutches of poverty which burdens most Namibians. Given the veracity that freedom of religion is guaranteed by article 21 of the Namibian Constitution, the study recommends that as new churches proliferate in Namibia at a supersonic pace, religious tolerance needs to be elevated and embraced by all Namibians.

Ecumenically, the study underscores that both earlier denominations and new churches should be reminded of the stark reality that in modern society, all churches are to some degree minorities and need one another.

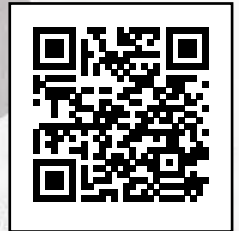
